Summery

The session started with how anthropogenic activities have severely impacted the resources availability on the planet and how E-waste has reached the most pristine places on the planet which were thought to be E-waste free. The impact of E-waste pollution has wider consequences than people can imagine. The attendees were shown a few pictures of littered beaches and mountains to show how human behavior can negatively impact an entire ecosystem.
