Zecomy provided a detail information on types of ewaste, how to identify and store safely, the bad effects of ewaste if not recycled properly and also demonstrated how to properly dispose of it and associated benefit for the community and the environment at large.







# Event - 2: e-Waste Collection Drive from the community and industries around Krishnagiri

#### Details of the event -2:

Zecomy arranged an e-waste collection drive between 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> May 2023, most of the individuals attended the ewaste awareness drive on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2023 donated some of their ewaste as part of their sustainable disposal practice. In addition, Zecomy was able to collect almost 1.75 Tonnes of ewaste during the two days drive from the community and small industries. These collected ewaste is now being handed over to a responsible recycler who is authorised to recycle as per the regulations laid out by the MOEF&CC/ Pollution Control Board. Each of the donors are given Green Warrior Certificate as an encouragement to spread the spirit of responsible disposal of all types of ewaste in their community for a Greener Planet.
